

All the living parts of an environment that live together and interact with one another

Not or Abiotic without












All the non-living parts of an environment (physical factors)

Interdependence



- No organism is isolated.
- All organisms are interconnected.
- Non-living things affect living things

Habitat



Habitat - Place where an organism or community of organisms live, including all biotic and abiotic factors or conditions
